



1 **APTA TECHNICAL ADVISORY GROUP ON EVOLVING PRACTICE MODELS**

2 **Charge**

3 The Board's determined charge for the Evolving Practice Models TAG is to:

- 4 • Describe the inventory of practice expansion opportunities that currently exist.
- 5 • Develop a comprehensive inventory of barriers to practice expansion and care coordination across settings, populations, and jurisdictions.
- 6 • Recommend a short list of high-value opportunities for further exploration, development, advocacy, or piloting.
- 7 • Propose a structured prioritization framework to evaluate which opportunities APTA should pursue to advance practice and coordination of care.
- 8 • Provide insights to inform member-facing tools and resources that empower clinicians and practice leaders to adopt evolving practice models and innovate their care delivery.
- 9 • Submit a comprehensive report to the Board of Directors on its findings and recommendations.

16 All APTA appointed groups shall conduct their work to support APTA's Mission, Vision, Strategic Framework, and APTA adopted policies and positions. All appointees shall agree to the APTA Volunteer Agreement.

19 **Qualifications of Appointees**

20 Each physical therapist member shall be APTA members in good standing. Collectively, the group will represent a balanced mix of expertise, including:

- 22 • Clinical leaders with experience in PT-first, direct access, and other innovative care delivery models across diverse practice settings
- 23 • Researchers and subject-matter experts
- 24 • Payment, policy, and regulatory experts
- 25 • Digital health/technology-enabled practice experts
- 26 • Representatives with experience in PT-PTA team models

28 **Meetings**

29 The group meets virtually as needed at least monthly.

1 **Size of Appointed Group**

2 The group shall consist of one APTA Board liaison and five additional members appointed
3 by Appointments Board Work Group.

4 **Terms of Appointees**

5 With the exception of the Board chair, group members shall serve a six-month term. APTA
6 members shall not serve on more than one board-appointed group at a time with the
7 exception of APTA Board members or member of a technical advisory group.
